From the Pastor's Heart

We welcome our guests today to worship at Beallwood. It is our prayer and anticipation that we all will encounter the Lord and His presence today. Worship, as we read about it in the Bible, was always a life-transforming encounter with God. That is my heart's desire today for my life and the lives of our church family. May our hearts be very open and sensitive to His work in us today! May we all leave this place a different people!

Over the course of the last few weeks, I have had a strong inclination to lay aside the preparation that I had for preaching from the book of 1 Thessalonians, beginning in April. As I have prayed and sought to understand God's leadership and direction for our church, I have sensed a need for us to look very closely at the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the church in the book of Acts. I have a sense, as I examine and read Acts and think about Beallwood, that one of our greatest needs is the understanding and appropriation of the Holy Spirit and His work in our lives. I am going to make a statement, and you may disagree, and that is OK, but I sense that there is something profoundly missing in many of our lives today. I don't think what is missing is Biblical knowledge, sincerity of worship, desire to serve, activity in service, or, necessarily, adequate worship. However, there is a longing in the hearts of many of God's people for a fresh touch from God. Many realize there is barrenness in their souls and emptiness and unproductively in their Christian living. The need of the church is not going to be met by filling our calendars with more activities, more ministry opportunities, more Bible Study, new and innovative programming (whatever that is), or more sincere dedication; it is going to take the Holy Spirit doing His work in our lives. Please pray for me today and for the next few weeks as I humbly and intentionally lead us to examine the Holy Spirit's work in Acts and how it will assist us.

Vacation Bible School is June 5-9, and our theme this year is "Ocean Commotion," which deals with the study of Noah's Flood. This is going to be a great study this year as we plunge into the depth of God's Word and discover wonderful insights in what God did during the flood. This global flood is one of those childhood Bible Stories that has captured the attention of each of us. I want to encourage all of our leadership to please be present today for a brief thirty-minute meeting to get resources and prepare for June.

Church family, please remember that Julian Sims and family will be with us on Sunday, April 24. We look forward to welcoming this family with a wonderful fellowship and pounding. Please make your preparations for our time on that Sunday. We look forward as well to a special time that morning as we begin our journey with Julian and his family.

May we all be encouraged throughout the week as we walk with the Lord! May He fill you with His grace and love. I thank the Lord for each of you. Pray for me as I do for you.
