From the Pastor's Heart

As we gather for worship today, we are in the midst of celebrating two hundred forty years of our existence as a free nation. The Lord has been gracious and good to America. In response, it would be wise counsel for Americans to humble themselves and seek the blessing stated in Psalm 33:12: "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord..." We are a nation that no longer acknowledges God or His Lordship. America is a deeply troubled nation that now finds herself radically divided; we are without wise, godly leadership and in the midst of some very disturbing times. The America that I knew as a boy, though not perfect, was vastly more Christ-centered than she is today. This is not an appeal to return to the good old days. However, it is an appeal for Christian people to realize that we must act and respond to the spiritual, moral, and family crises that we currently face as a nation. We can no longer treat matters with a "business as usual" attitude. These are desperate times, and we need commensurate desperate action. My fear is that many of us as Christians have allowed the culture to immunize us with such materialism, busyness, pleasure, and indifference that we are no longer mobilized to do anything. We need a baptism of repentance among God's people and a radical commitment to our Lord and Savior. It is doubtless time for us to give prayerful consideration to our circumstances.

This morning in worship, we will be commissioning a group from our church that will be going to Manchester, Kentucky, to minister. May I encourage our church family to make it our commitment to pray for them each day as they serve! Pray for good health, for safe travel, for souls to be saved, for the churches to be strengthened, and for Christ to be lifted up as they serve.

May I remind our church family to give prayerful thought and consideration to the *Every Member in Ministry* material! God has gifted us and called us to serve. This is a very practical and personal way for you to enlist and become engaged in what the Lord desires to do in and through Beallwood.

The Mexico Mission team is in need of reading glasses. If you would like to donate your old reading glasses or purchase inexpensive new ones from a Dollar Store, they need to have magnification of at least 3.5. Please place these in the box in the hallway going into the fellowship hall. We will be commissioning the team on Sunday morning, July 10, so please pray for them as they make their final preparations.

Wayne and Roni Ragan are in Taiwan serving in a leadership camp with some of our IMB personnel. As many are aware, they are also praying about returning for an additional three years of service there. May I encourage our church family to pray for them as they will return to Beallwood on July 22. Pray for the Lord to give them clear focus and direction as to what He would have them to do.
