From the Pastor's Heart

This morning in worship, we will be looking at a passage that gives us an insight into the early Church. Luke, on several occasions, recaps what life was like in the early Church. This is the second such account that Luke provides about the state of the Church. Though he paints with broad strokes the life of the Church, it is very interesting how pointed he is about what he observes. Though the Church in Acts is not perfect, it is evident that the power of God is all over the Church. I would be quick to say that the atmosphere and presence about the Church are unique. The traits that are seen are characteristics of a healthy Church. So, this morning we are going to focus on "A Church That Honors Jesus."

As we continue to think about the Church in Acts and how that applies to Beallwood, I cannot help but ask, "What does it take for Beallwood to come to this place?" As we have looked at Acts, we have discovered several key components that surface and continue in each page of the book. One of the first is the church's insatiable passion for the Lord Jesus. The Church is deeply passionate and committed to Jesus. Second, telling people about Jesus and helping them come to faith in Jesus are all over the pages. Third, the power and presence of the Holy Spirit are acutely evident in every person. And fourth, the Church is making a difference in the culture and in people's lives. There are no doubt other matters that catch our attention, but these all are so evident.

I must confess that often the question lingers in my mind as to why this is not more evident at Beallwood, in my personal life, and in the life of the Church in general today. Please don't take this with a grain of salt, and please don't think that I stand in condemnation of the Church. But my heart is often stirred and probed by the Holy Spirit when we seem to make so small an impact in our culture. This concern continues to drive me to my knees to cry out to God to do a fresh work in my heart and in the life of the Church. I wonder sometimes if what Jesus said about the Church at Ephesus in Revelation 2 is not true of us today. Jesus, though complimentary of the Church, did tell her that she had forsaken her first love. This may be the heart of the issue.

Please pray for me as I do for you. May God's grace and peace be yours today and throughout this week. Please make every effort to reach and share with that one that God has brought into your life.
