From the Pastor's Heart

November ushers in not only the celebration of Thanksgiving but one of my favorite times of the year. It is the beginning of our focus on the **Lottie Moon International Mission Offering**. The week of December 1-8, 2019, will be the week of prayer for the Lottie Moon Offering. The goal for the Southern Baptist Convention is 165 million dollars, and our goal at Beallwood is fifty-two thousand, four hundred dollars. This is a reachable goal for Southern Baptists and for Beallwood Baptists. It will take each church and each member of each church to reach the national and church goal. Think with me about the impact that we can have by participating in this offering. We will be part of placing 3,678 missionaries on the field, we will engage 847 people groups, we will be able to celebrate the 77,605 new believers who were reached in the last year, we will be part of assisting in planting 13,898 new churches, we will share in celebrating the 52,586 baptisms this year, and we will continue to engage over 10,000 unreached people groups. This is all possible through the Lottie Moon International Mission Offering. No one church can do this alone, but Beallwood Baptist can be part of making a global impact by giving prayerfully, faithfully, sacrificially, and obediently to the Lottie Moon Offering this year. Are you Ready? Well, as for me and my house, we are ready, we can't wait, and, as a matter of fact, we are already giving to help reach our goal of fifty-two thousand four hundred dollars. So, let's all pray up and gear up to give this year.

Let's not forget about the **Thanksgiving Celebration** for our community on Saturday, November 23, at 5:30 in the afternoon. This is one way we can impact and begin to reach our community for Christ. May I also remind our church family that we have visitation this Sunday, November 10, at 2:30 to reach out to prospective families. Also, to assist us in preparing for the event, Sunday night, November 17, at 6:00 during worship, we will have our team meetings to go through the details of this event. If you have volunteered to assist with the Thanksgiving Celebration, then you will need to be at the meeting on Sunday night, the 17th, for the preparation time. See you this afternoon at 2:30 for visitation.

The theme for our 2020 Stewardship Campaign is **"Prove His Faithfulness – Give."** It has been a joy for over fifty years to know and walk with the Lord. One of the valuable lessons that I learned as a young Christian was to give. When I worked as a florist in Opelika and drove a school bus my junior and senior years in high school, I gave ten percent of what the Lord gave to me. Fifty years have passed, and there have been some challenging times as a seminary student, as a young family, and even now as a senior adult, but my Father has been faithful. I have heard it said all my life, "You

can't out-give God." And I can echo that sentiment this day. The Lord has provided for our family through the years. One of the greatest joys and privileges that we have is that of giving. May I challenge each family in our church to prayerfully seek the Lord as to what you and your family will give in 2020. Let's make this a banner year and prove the faithfulness of our Father.
