From the Pastor's Heart

Resurrection Day and all that took place the week in which Jesus died and was resurrected were the greatest tragedy and greatest victory of human history. I know that many will ask, "How can I say that this week was the greatest tragedy?" But just think about what happened on that Friday before the Resurrection in its historical setting. Jesus, the Son of God, who had never sinned, who had done nothing but good all His life, was falsely accused, beaten, cursed, mistreated, rejected, and crucified for sins that He never committed.
