When God Listens

Did you ever wonder if God is listening when you pray? We know the Scriptures teach us that “*God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.*” [Ps 46:1] It is good to know this, but when does He listen to His people? Are there specific times when He might listen more intently?

God heard when Ishmael cried in the desert and He provided deliverance [Gen 21:17]. God heard when the children of Israel cried out while under the burden of their taskmasters in Egypt [Ex 2:24]. The psalmist said God heard him saying, “*This poor man cried out, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles.*” [Ps 34:6]. And God also heard when the people grumbled against Him and Moses in the wilderness [Num 11:1] . . . and it made Him angry (ouch!).

The truth is God hears and knows everything, even every idle word [“*But I say unto you, that every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.*” Matt 12:36].

But there are times when I just need to know God hears me and I usually think I know it when He acts on my behalf. So, when does He hear me? When I ask [Ps 86:1-4]. When I praise Him [Ps 22:3]. When I am broken hearted about my sin [Ps 51:17]. And many more times. But the time I need Him to hear me most is expressed in Romans 10:13, “*For whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.*” I need Him most of all to save me from my sin, deliver me from my unrighteousness, and receive me in His arms when I leave this world. With as many needs as I think I have, this is my greatest need, and I am thankful He has heard me.
