2023 Giving to Capital Improvements Fund: \$100.00 This morning in Sunday School we studied the call of God on the life of a young Jeremiah (Jeremiah 1:4-10). We learned that God knew Jeremiah before he was even conceived. That God, even before he was born, had separated him for a purpose, had a plan for his life. God called him to be a prophet (preacher).

Jeremiah, similar to Moses, questioned God's call on his life. He thought he was too young. He thought he didn't know what to say.

God's answer was fourfold: 1) don't say you're too young, implied, don't make excuses; 2) go where I tell you to go; 3) say what I tell you to say; and 4) don't be afraid.

I had the privilege of studying this passage in seminary in my Hebrew class. As I did, my eyes lighted on the words "the word of the LORD came to me," in verse four. I wanted to know what it meant for the word of the LORD to come. In thirteen of sixteen translations the word is translated "came." The word of the LORD happened to Jeremiah. In other words, the word of the LORD was not merely letters on a page, it was a personal experience that happened in Jeremiah's soul.

This morning the hour has come. We have the opportunity to vote on whether to call a new pastor, Dr. David Mills. Our Transitional Search Team has worked diligently. They have prayed fervently as they have been seeking God's will. For them, the word of the LORD has happened.

The moment of decision is upon us. Listen carefully, pray intently and see how you will experience the word of the LORD? How will it happen for you today?
